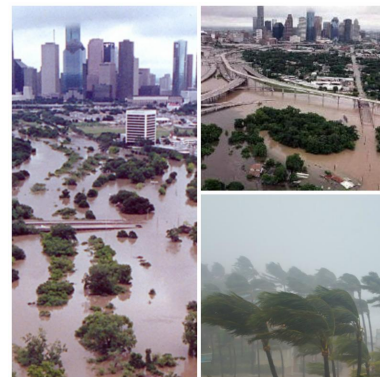

Preparing for Hurricane Season:

Hurricanes can be deadly, and that's why it is so important to prepare your places of business and homes ahead of time. To prepare for an emergency situation, here is a list of items you will need on hand.



Hurricane Preparedness Checklist:

- Canned food supplies for 3-5 days and a manual can opener
- Minimum of 3 gallons of drinking water per person
- Protective clothing, rainwear, bedding or sleeping bags
- Batteries
- Battery-powered radio, flashlight, clock
- Special-needs items for infants, the elderly or physically challenged
- Full gas tank
- Cash
- Fully charged cell phone with a car charger accessory
- Pet supplies
- Protective, waterproof storage area for important documents

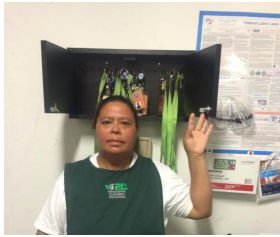
